Part 2:

Evaluation of the Effectiveness on the Use of the Promotion of Reading Grant

Evaluation of the objective and strategies

The major objective is to create a Reading Culture, more than 50% of the grant has been used for both English and Chinese Language in promoting of the Extensive Reading Grant. Grant has been including replacement of old readers and new books for the Thematic Display : Author of the Year. During summer vacation we have subscribed online Chinese eBooks from 金閱閣, thus it can facilitate students to read and finish summer assignment.

For Reading Activities, grant has been used for hiring Professional, Miss Tong Hei Man (唐希文) to conduct talks. S1 Book Sharing have been arranged during CCA. The students are very attentive and highly engaged.

For other panels like IS panel also aims at purchasing printed books for to enhance STEM Education.

In order to maximize the use of the Grant, different panels also using the Grant from purchasing printed books to promote reading on themed-based reading activities

To conclude, by the start of the academic year 2022, we still have surplus of \$46,302.51 under Promotion of Reading Grant, \$83,026.3650.57 of the Grant have been used and we still have surplus of 27,258.15 for the coming years.
